Qualification Criteria

This award is presented to an organization. To be eligible the organization must have:

1. A clearly defined IT project with dedicated management personnel
2. A project start date of no later than June 1, 2017
3. Well documented and communicated purpose/goals/objectives
4. A defined budget for the project
5. Clearly defined and documented critical path, milestones and metrics for the project
6. A demonstrated commitment to IT best practices with involvement of certified staff

The Submission Process

The Submission Form on the next page should be completed and sent via email to conferences@pinkelephant.com. Submissions received after **December 8, 2017** may not be considered for this current year's award, but will be retained for the following year.

We will acknowledge receipt of your submission within one business day and request more detailed information as the evaluation and selection process proceeds.

The Evaluation & Selection Process

The Judging Committee will evaluate all submissions and a short list of finalists will be contacted for a phone interview.

Submissions making it to the finalist stage will each qualify for one complimentary pass to Pink Elephant's 22nd Annual International IT Service Management Conference & Exhibition at the JW Marriott, Grande Lakes, Orlando on February 18-21, 2018 where the winners will be announced.
